

LiveDAYBREAK Teen Scholarship Program

LiveDAYBREAK is accepting applications from high school junior and seniors who wish to be considered for a college scholarship. All applications received will be carefully reviewed by LiveDAYBREAK staff, who will make suggestions to the LiveDAYBREAK Board of Directors, who will then choose who to award scholarships. Two (2) \$1,000 LiveDAYBREAK Teen Leadership Scholarships will be awarded.

2020 SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- i. Must be active Junior or Senior in High School
- ii. Must be Daybreak resident
- iii. Though not required, but preferably is a member of the LiveDAYBREAK Teen Leadership Council
- iv. Applicant must be enrolled at a post-secondary institution (University, four-year College, Community College or Vocational School) for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- v. Must have submitted application on or before May 30, 2020.

A COMPLETE APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- i. A correctly filled out Application Form (attached)
- ii. A personal essay of 150 words on why you deserve this scholarship
- iii. All applicants are required to plan an activity or project based on at least one LiveDAYBREAK pillar (Lifelong Learning, Healthy Living, Giving Back, Connecting, Arts & Diversity), and must provide evidence for:
 - a. What activity was
 - b. When then activity took place
 - c. Where the activity took place (preferably Daybreak)
 - d. How the activity related to the selected LiveDAYBREAK pillar
 - e. How the activity impacted your community
 - f. Any supporting financials
 - g. At least (3) supporting photos

Applicants maybe be asked for an interview following submission

SUBMITTAL

The LiveDAYBREAK Teen Leadership Scholarship will be awarded in July, 2020 Applications must be submitted to LiveDAYBREAK in format that best fits applicant (Word, PowerPoint, video, etc.)
