

Personal Floatation Device Information

In order to promote patron safety, all Daybreak aquatic facilities only allow the use of Coastguard Approved Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs). These devices must have their original tag or label indicating this approval. Please see information below regarding label content & use guidelines.

PFD LABELS

The product label found on each PFD contains important information from the manufacturer.

The label includes information about:

- The PFDs intended uses
- The size of person it will fit
- Care instructions
- How to wear the PFD

Check the label to of your PFD to ensure that the it is Coast Guard-approved. Coast Guard approval means that the design & manufacture of the PFD has met specific standards of buoyancy & construction. PFDs that are Coast Guard-approved are marked with a “Type” designation & descriptive name to indicate the performance level that the device is intended to provide.

IMPORTANT! Always adhere to the information on the label. Using a PFD outside of its indicated restrictions and intended use is illegal and can result in penalties, or more significantly, the loss of a life.
