Splash Pool Rules

- A bather using the facility must take a cleansing shower before entering the splash pool. A bather leaving the splash pool to use the toilet must take a second cleansing shower before returning to the splash pool.
- 2. A person having a communicable disease transmissible by water must be excluded from public pools. A person having any exposed sub-epidermal tissue, including open blisters, cuts, or other lesions may not use a public pool. A person who has or has had diarrhea within the last two weeks caused by an unknown source or from any communicable or fecal-borne disease may not enter the pool.
- 3. Any child under three years old, any child not toilet trained, and any one who lacks control of defecation shall wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swim wear. Swim diapers and waterproof swim wear shall have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
- All food and glass containers are not permitted in the splash pool and locker room area. Smoking and alcohol are prohibited on the premises.
- 5. Diapers shall be changed only in restrooms or changing stations and shall not be changed at pool side. The person who changes the diaper must wash their hands thoroughly with soap before returning to the splash pool.

 The diapered person must undergo a cleansing shower before returning to pool.

- 6. Please walk on the splash pool deck. Roughhousing, dunking, shoulder fights and abusive language are not permitted.
- 7. *Inner tubes, inflatable baby carriers, or any large pool toys/objects that may impede the attendant's ability to see all areas of the pool are strictly prohibited.

Items below are allowed in the pool:

- Soft or inflatable pool toys 12" or less in diameter.
- Water noodles
- Coastguard Approved Personal Floatation Devices (see PFD info sheet for more information)
- Water wings
- 8. *Persons 14 years of age and over must have a valid Daybreak resident ID to be admitted to the facility.
- *Children 13 years of age and younger must be accompanied by a guardian 18 years of age or older.
- 10.*A parent or guardian 18+ years of age must accompany all children under 9 and be within arms reach at all times.
- 11.*The splash pool is designed for use by parents and their children under the age of 7.
- 12.*Diving, flips, twists, back dives, and all other unsafe activities are prohibited.
- 13.*The splash pool is a Daybreak resident exclusive amenity. Use of the splash pool is for residents and their guests only. All guests must be accompanied by a Daybreak resident at all times.

Pool employees are responsible for maintaining a safe pool area. They reserve the right to enforce any rules not listed in order to maintain the health & safety of patrons.
